ASPIRA of Florida, Inc, Broward Division, conducted their 14th Annual Awards Ceremony on Friday, May 29, 2009, at the Signature Grand in Davie, Florida. The Awards Ceremony celebrates the accomplishments of our Aspirantes (students) and the honoring of the community leaders and organizations that have supported the ASPIRA mission throughout the year.
